ROUNABOUT RIBBON CUTTING AND NUGGET AVENUE GRAND RE-OPENING AUGUST 4

SPARKS, Nev. – In celebration of the completion of a project that's been in the works for about 30 years, John Ascuaga's Nugget will host a ribbon cutting ceremony at the new Nugget Avenue Roundabout at 9:30 a.m. on August 4.

The new roundabout is on Nugget Avenue between 14th Street and I-80. Cars will now be able to enter and exit the lot directly on Nugget Avenue. It will also allow access to the lot from Nugget Ave heading west from 14th Street.

John Ascuaga, president and founder of John Ascuaga's Nugget, will speak at the ceremony and cut the ceremonial ribbon with his daughter, Michonne, CEO and son Stephen, COO.

As a tribute to the construction being complete in time for Hot August Nights and the Nugget's new drag racing event, several classic cars will be the first to travel down the I-80 Nugget Avenue ramp and around the new roundabout.
