## **THREE DOG NIGHT BRINGS 'JOY TO THE WORLD' AT JOHN ASCUAGA'S NUGGET**

Reno/Sparks, NEV - Three Dog Night has been rocking the charts for more than 40 years. On December 10, 2011 they bring their legendary rock style to the Celebrity Show Room at John Ascuaga's Nugget for one night only.

From 1969-1974, no other group, moved more records, sold more concert tickets or achieved more top 10 hits. Three Dog Night continues to top the list of artists with the best "Billboard Top 100 Chart" average.

The group had 21 consecutive Top 40 hits, 18 straight Top 20's, 11 Top 10's, three number 1's, seven million-selling singles and 12 straight RIAA Certified Gold LPs. Three Dog Night's hits appeared on best selling charts in all genres (pop, rock and country). To this day, their records, including three generation-defining No. 1 hits – Mama Told Me (Not To Come), Joy to The World, and Black and White – continue to sell around the world. Tens of millions of Three Dog Night records have been sold through the years.

In the fall of 2009, Three Dog Night began adding new songs to their arsenal by releasing their first double-A sided single in nearly 25 years. The blistering performance of "Heart Of Blues" and the timely, beautiful a-cappella ballad "Prayer of the Children" are available at iTunes, Amazon, and other digital retailers as well as at the band's official website ([www.threedognight.com](http://www.threedognight.com)). They have also released a Three Dog Night iPhone app to keep fans up to date on new music, tour dates and other news.

Three Dog Night's signature sound, delivered to audiences spanning generations, currently features founding members Cory Wells and Danny Hutton on lead vocals, as well as original keyboardist Jimmy Greenspoon and guitarist Michael Allsup. Paul Kingery (bass and vocals) and Pat Bautz (drums) complete the lineup.

Three Dog Night continues touring extensively, performing in a variety of venues often with symphony orchestras. Since 1986, they have played more than 2,000 shows including two Super Bowls.

Three Dog Night performs Saturday, December 10 at 9 p.m. in the Celebrity Showroom. Tickets are \$50, and are available by calling (800) 648-1177 or (775) 356-3300 or by visiting [janugget.com](http://janugget.com). Steppin' Out Dinner and Show packages are also available.
